
# NMR Spectroscopy Database and Searching System

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


#### **Abstract**

NMR spectroscopy is the most important analytical technology for organic compounds and plays the key role for the chemical characterizations and identifications in chemistry, pharmacy, materials science, environments, biology, and many related fields. ## Typical Presentation Methods for a NMR Spectrum


## A. Graphic Presentation: Good for human reading




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#### B. Numerical Description: Good for digital searching
